OBJECTION TO INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

Members of the Mason City Community School District community may object to the instructional and library materials utilized in the school district and ask for their use to be reconsidered.

It will be the responsibility of the superintendent, in conjunction with administrative staff, to develop administrative regulations for reconsideration of instructional materials.

Parents or guardians of students enrolled in the district have the ability to request that their student not be able to check out certain library materials.
