Covid-19 Screening Questions for EVERYONE INVOLVED:

These screening questions will need to be answered by all parents/guardians and staff prior to coming for pickup. If you answer 'yes' to any of the following questions and are unable to pick up your child's Chromebook on the assigned days please call your building principal to arrange a separate pick up.

- 1. Have you in the past 14 days traveled internationally?
- 2. Have you in the past 14 days traveled outside of lowa?
- 3. Have you in the past 14 days been in contact with someone diagnosed with or guarantined for Covid-19?
- 4. Have you had a fever (temp greater than 100.4 degrees F) in the last 3 days?
- 5. Do you have a cough?
- 6. Do you have any shortness of breath?

All schools will have a drive up service to pick up Chromebooks per the schedule below.

This service will be to distribute Chromebooks to students in grades 3-12 if they do not have access to their own device. Please be patient with this process as we work to get you the materials you need.
